Employers rate VET

Another good reason to consider VET as an excellent pathway to find the career you want has been highlighted in a recent study. The National Centre for Vocational Education Research (NCVER), has just released a publication regarding employers use and views of the Vocational Education and Training (VET) System.

The encouraging news is that employer satisfaction with the VET system, as a way of meeting their skill needs, is high at:

- 84.8% for employers with jobs requiring vocational qualifications
- 82.7% for employers with apprentices and trainees
- 88.5% for employers using nationally recognised training (which was not part of an apprenticeship or traineeship).

Of those businesses surveyed, just over a third have jobs requiring vocational qualifications. Of these employers:

- The main reasons for having jobs that require vocational qualifications are to meet legislative, regulatory or licensing requirements (52.7%), and to provide the skills required for the job (40.8%).
