A 'Closing the Gap' initiative for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples

The Indigenous Australian Government Development Program (IAGDP) is an employment and development initiative administered by the Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations (DEEWR) on behalf of partnering Australian Public Service (APS) Agencies.

The aim of the IAGDP is to increase the representation of Indigenous Australians in the APS by providing work experience and professional development.

The IAGDP offers eligible candidates:

- Ongoing (permanent) employment, initially at an APS 3 level;
- A Diploma qualification; and
- Access to additional structured learning and development courses.

Upon successful completion of the program (including the Diploma qualification), participants are advanced to an APS 4 level and will continue to work with their home agency.

In 2012, participants will complete a Diploma qualification which may include:

- Contract Management
- Project Management
- Community Capacity
- Information and Communication Technology
