



CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Entry

- Artists must be of Indigenous decent, and reside in the interior regional as indicated on the map on the back page.
- Entries must be the original work of the exhibitor, and completed within the last FIVE years.
- No limit on the number or size of entries.
- Entries are hung at the discretion of the committee.
- Permission to reproduce entries for the purpose of publicity, catalogue
- production and archival processes will be assumed unless otherwise specified.
- Works can be any medium.
- All works shall be held for the duration of the exhibition.

ALL ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY 8 SEPTEMBER 2013.

2. Presentation

- All works must be clearly marked with the artist's name, address, title
 of work, medium, sale price.
- All artworks must be suitably prepared for presentation e.g. Quilts must have rod pocket necessary for hanging, any props for 3 D entries must be supplied.
- Entries can be framed or not framed.
- Any framed works to be hung, must be equipped with 2 1/2- inch "D" rings attached.

3. Packaging

- Proper packaging of any work is the responsibility of the artist. All care will be taken with the works, but no responsibility for loss or damage will be accepted.
- The committee undertakes to repack unsold works, in the packing it is received in, and returned to entrant via nominated freight transporter to be paid for by the entrant.
- Entries unclaimed with in one month of the close of the exhibition shall become the property of Red Ridge, and may be disposed off.

4. Sale of works

 Artists must have their works available for sale. Please state the selling price on the entry form. The Hall of Fame will charge 25% commission plus 10% GST on commission on all sales.

5. Insurance & Freight of works

• The artist is responsible for freight on all works. Freight and insurance of works must be paid for by the entrant to and from Longreach.

6. Delivery of works

- Works are to be delivered to the Stockman's Hall of Fame, Clearly marked MY EARTH CALLS EXHIBITION.
