The organisations' objectives are:

- 1. To respond to the needs of young women aged 12 25 years who are homeless or at-risk of homelessness,
- 2. To assist young women who are in the target group to identify their personal issues and needs and to provide the opportunity for the development of skills to deal with issues and achieve greater self-reliance,
- 3. Commitment to providing young women with a safe and supportive environment,
- 4. To ensure that the rights of the target group to independent expression, decision and action are recognised and that they are given respect, dignity and consideration,
- 5. To provide a range of services at Girl's Time Out which fosters diversity within the target group,
- 6. To encourage peer group support for young women,
- 7. Commitment to ensuring that services and resources provided are socially and culturally appropriate by involving women in the decision making processes of the organisation
- 8. Commitment to working collaboratively with other agencies to ensure best outcomes for the target group.

Membership Process - Once applications forms are received, they will be handed to the Management Committee for admission or rejection. (1) At the next meeting of the Management Committee, application shall be considered by the Management Committee, who shall thereupon determine upon the admission or rejection of the applicant. (2) Any applicant who receives a consensus or failing this, a majority of the votes of the members of the Management Committee present at the meeting at which such application is being considered, shall be accepted as a member to the class of membership applied for. (3) Upon the acceptance or rejection of an application for any class of membership the secretary shall forthwith give the applicant notice in writing of such acceptance or rejection.
