Due to the growth in the resource sector, the below skills have been identified as a skill shortage.

To ensure that Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people take advantage of the growth, the QWSS will assist individuals to develop capacity to increase their chances of obtaining and retaining employment in the CSG/LNG industry and associated supply chain.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the program, participants must:

- Be of Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander descent
- Identify as an Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander
- Be accepted as an Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander by the community in which they live or have lived
- Be able to pass a drug and alcohol test and pre employment medical assessment

Note: If you have participated in another employment program in the last 6 months please indicate as this may affect your eligibility

The QWSS comprises the following components:

Employment readiness and training - 2 weeks

- Induction and orientation
- Individual case plans
- Life and personal skills communication, teamwork, problem solving, planning, organising, self–management, conflict resolution
- Cultural competence/awareness
- Work expectations
- Resumes
- Construction Safety White Card

Industry engagement experience

Through guest speakers and/or industry tours, participants will gain an insight into the CSG/LNG and local Industry.

Accredited training - 2 to 4 weeks

Selected industry skills sets from a Certificate II qualification from the following

- Drilling
- Trades Assisstant
- Camp Operators
- Traffic Controllers

Post participation support and mentoring

Once employment has commenced, the QWSS program graduates continue to receive ongoing mentoring and post placement support for a further six months, with the support of the community.
