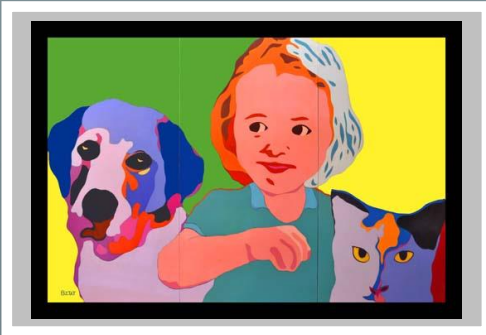


A trauma informed model for working with children and young people exhibiting problem sexual behaviours



A four stage trauma informed model for working with children and young people exhibiting problem sexual behaviours:

1. Assessment
2. Safety and Containment
3. Therapeutic intervention for symptom reduction and regulation
4. Systemic intervention: the care context and socio-educational environment

Rationale for this training

In Australia there has been much interest and emphasis in child sexual abuse perpetrated on a child/children by an adult. Protocols and therapeutic interventions have developed to help these children. There has been much less early intervention and therapeutic focus on children and young people who exhibit problem sexual behaviours towards other children, young people and adults. Parents, teachers and foster carers working with children exhibiting problem sexual behaviours need knowledge, frameworks and skills for working with this population of children and young people.

Objectives

At the end of this two day training, participants will:

- Be able to distinguish healthy sexual development and behaviours in children and young people, from problem sexual development and behaviours
- Have multiple frameworks for understanding the aetiology of problem sexual behaviours
- Learn how attachment theory can be understood and utilized as a theory of arousal regulation
- Learn how the body and brain function at times of trauma
- Learn multi-modal therapeutic techniques for helping children and young people process traumatic events and memories
- Learn a program of teaching and modelling social skills to young people with problem sexual behaviours which broadens their window of tolerance to arousal
- Learn how to work with, and integrate a child or young person with problem sexual behaviours into, their community of care
