

# Application form









#### About the program

The Queensland Indigenous Youth Leadership Program is an exciting opportunity for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander young people to develop their leadership skills and to gain first-hand experience of Queensland's democratic processes.

This six-day residential program will be held in Brisbane from 21 to 26 June 2014. All travel, meals and accommodation will be provided for participants.

Young Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people, aged 18 to 25 years, from remote, regional and urban communities across Queensland and from a variety of employment and educational backgrounds are strongly encouraged to apply.

#### **Advice for applicants**

- You must complete all sections of the application form.
- Provide as much information as you can about activities or projects you are currently involved in and why you are interested in participating in the program.
- When answering the questions, provide details about your:
  - communication and teamwork skills
  - leadership skills and experience
  - knowledge of community issues
  - motivation
  - your vision for your community.
- Use examples from your past or present employment, voluntary work, educational
  achievements and any relevant hobbies or community activities. When you give an example,
  provide an explanation of the situation, what you contributed, the result you achieved and
  what you learned.
- Past experience in participating in other leadership programs is not necessary.
- Please limit your written responses to a maximum of 150 words.
- If you require more space to complete your application, or if you prefer to type your responses
  in a separate Word document, you can attach printouts of these to your application form and
  insert 'refer to attachment'. Please keep in mind the maximum word count for each response.
- A sample response is provided on the next page as a guide for answering questions.

#### Question

#### **Answer**

It would be an amazing experience to come together with other Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander young people with an interest in creating positive change within our communities. It would be a fantastic opportunity to learn leadership skills which I will be able to pass on to others. I would also like to learn more about Queensland's democratic processes and how these affect my people.

All applications must be received by **Wednesday 30 April 2014.** Please take into consideration postage times to ensure your application is received before the closing date.




