78% of participants in previous Given the Chance placements have successfully gained ongoing employment.

- Possess a higher education qualification (from an overseas or Australian institution)
- Effective communication and interpersonal skills
- Excellent numeracy and computer literacy
- Australian Citizen, Permanent Residency or Work Rights in Australia
- Sales or Customer Service experience an advantage
- Nil police record
