- Nominees must be sponsored by a Corporate Body
- Nominees must make him/herself available to attend NAIDOC Committee and community organised events during NAIDOC week.
- Nominees must be available to represent their sponsors at any event
- Nominees must be aware that their name and photograph may be used for publicity before and after the NAIDOC Week Celebrations in local media and on NAIDOC promotion material
- Nominees must all attend the NAIDOC March & Expo Day held on 8th July 2016
- Nomination fee is \$500 with part payment of \$250.00 to be paid with Registration on or before 30th April 2016. All Fundraising monies and remaining Nomination fee to be finalised by 3rd June 2016
