



## **FREE SOLAR POWER OPPORTUNITY FOR QUEENSLAND COMMUNITY GROUPS.**

The Queensland Government has encouraged the Gambling Community Benefit Fund (GCBF) committee to strongly consider approving grant applications for solar photovoltaic (PV) systems and new technologies, such as battery energy storage for the next funding round.

Eligible not-for-profit community groups or clubs can apply for grants of up to \$35,000 with the next round of funding scheduled to open mid April 2016 and close on midnight 31st of May 2016.

Solari Energy is now inviting eligible community groups or clubs that intend applying for this grant to install solar power on their premises, to respond with the following information to assist us with initial planning and system design.

We request you send us a letter from your committee stating your intention to apply for this grant to install solar and copies of your last three electricity bills so we can work out what size solar power system you will require. Once we receive this information we will respond with a proposal of the solar system we recommend installing together with the energy cost savings you could expect the system to provide. This proposal can then be sent together with your grant application for consideration by the GCBF.
