About the role

Safe Night Out will deliver support services to address alcohol-fuelled violence across designated Safe Night Precincts. The service will increase the safety and wellbeing of vulnerable people and those at risk of harm to themselves. This support will also extend to others affected by the influence of alcohol and other related substances.

The Outreach Worker will be required to:

- Provide basic first aid, care and support to individuals who need assistance as a result of intoxication or the intoxication of others
